REGULAR TERM COURSES beginning October 1, and February 1, each lasting sixteen weeks, are given in tropical pathology, bacteriology, parasitology, chemistry, clinical medicine, public health and communicable diseases.

A certificate in Tropical Medicine is granted upon the completion of an approval program of study.

A SHORT INTENSIVE COURSE planned especially for physicians and health officers is offered January 10 to February 1. In this course the commoner diseases of the American tropics will be considered in their pathological, clinical and public-health aspects. Correlation of laboratory, clinical and field studies is made possible by a close affiliation of the School with the Insular Department of Health.

In both the regular and the short courses the number of students is limited. A medical degree or equivalent preparation, is a prerequisite in all cases.

Opportunities for research in laboratory and field are open to qualified investigators during the entire year.
