FELLOWSHIP GIFT TO SCHOOL OF TROPICAL MEDICINE

A gift of \$10,000 has been received by the School of Tropical Medicine of the University of Porto Rico for the purpose of establishing a fellowship in tropical medicine. The fund is to be known as the Bailey K. Ashford Fund and the fellowship will be the Bailey K. Ashford Fellowship in tropical medicine.

It is the intent of the donor of this fund that the income be used to further scientific research in tropical medicine in Porto Rico. At the same time the gift honors one who has contributed largely to the field of tropical medicine and will stand for all time as a recognition of the brilliant work of Colonel Bailey K. Ashford, now professor of tropical medicine and mycology at the School of Tropical Medicine.

This is the first gift of its kind to the School of Tropical Medicine and it is gratifying to all that through one of its faculty members the School should be thus honored.
